- Increased satisfaction of program staff and families
- → Increases in teachers' competence and confidence in the support of children

# Physical Environment Designed to Promote Engagement: a Preschool Classroom Essential

Some helpful tips for ensuring that classroom space promotes engagement:

- ★ Enough centers to accommodate the number of children
- Centers have clear boundaries

- Materials are developmentally appropriate and adequate in number and variety
- ★ No wide-open spaces for children to run
- ★ Group area is clearly defined with enough space to accommodate the number of children
